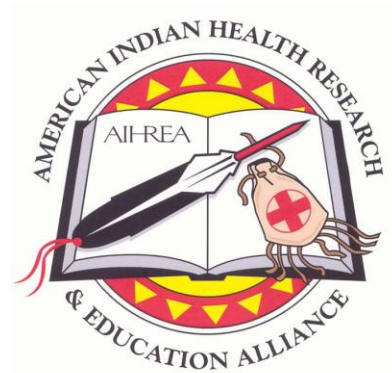
AIHREA Pow Wow Vendor/Exhibitor:
